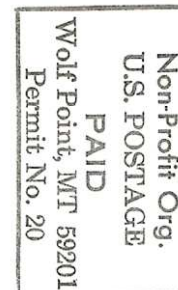
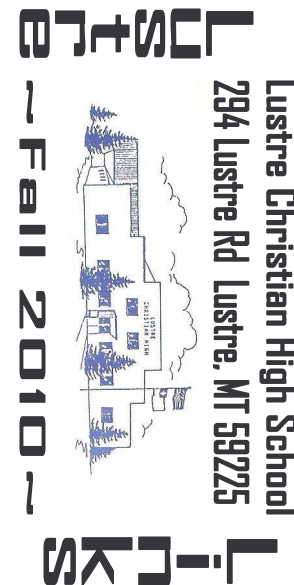

Letter from the President,

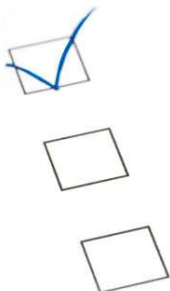
