Alumni and MB Harvest Festival Speaker, Les Zerbe spoke in chapel on Tuesday, October 4, 2011. His topic was "The Lost Art of Listening." His grandfather always told him that there is hearing, and there is listening. Eli and Samuel illustrate this in I Samuel 3. Eli was not listening, but Samuel was. The elder had to ask the younger what God told him, and it was a very sad message. Because of Eli's sin and his allowing his sons to sin in the tabernacle, he and his family were cursed!

Then Mr. Zerbe told two stories from his

experiences as a missionary aviator in Alaska, where hearing and not listening led to big problems. Howard and Fran were a couple of city slickers who wanted to live off the land. They talked Tom, an experienced old-timer, into helping them the first winter in a remote area, and they made it to early spring. The old man told them over and over that the next month they were to be on high alert as many bears came through the area on their way to lower eating areas, and the bears would suddenly appear out of nowhere. They

needed to be ready at all times, carrying their loaded rifle with the chamber full and safety on. They did not see any bears and got tired of carrying the heavy rifle. He would remind them again until finally Howard got obstinate and told the old man to stop treating him like a child. Later Howard was told to walk three miles back to the cabin alone, but he never made it. which also included widening the steps.

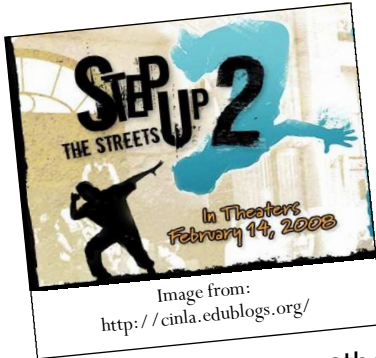

Acquire the Fire

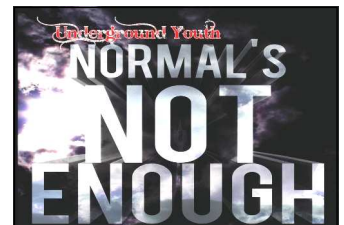
